Trinity Law School bucks nationwide trend: Enrollment up fourth consecutive year

Where law schools nationwide are seeing a double-digit decrease in enrollment, Trinity Law School, located in Santa Ana, California clearly stands out as being different. For the fourth consecutive year, this southern California law school has seen growth, significant growth. With a 42% increase over 2010 enrollment, Trinity's population has grown to a record high of 230 students. The law school's success is largely credited to a renewed recruitment effort that emphasizes the school's commitment to its Christian heritage, its practical approach to a legal education, and increased domestic and international opportunities to put that education into practice. In addition, the law school is dedicated to keeping its tuition among the lowest of California law schools and provides its students with many opportunities to obtain scholarships and Federal Financial Aid. Trinity Law School is a distinctly Christian institution and is one of the four schools of Trinity International University (head-quartered in Deerfield, IL). The law school is accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools and the Committee of Bar Examiners of the State Bar of California.
