The prescription drug cards can be used at over 80% participating pharmacies around the United States and Puerto Rico. Almost every major pharmaceutical chain accepts these free prescription cards including Rite Aid, Wal-mart, Target, Costco and Albertsons. When you bring the card to one of the participating pharmacies, you must simply present it to the representative and they will access your account to determine the savings for which you will be eligible.
